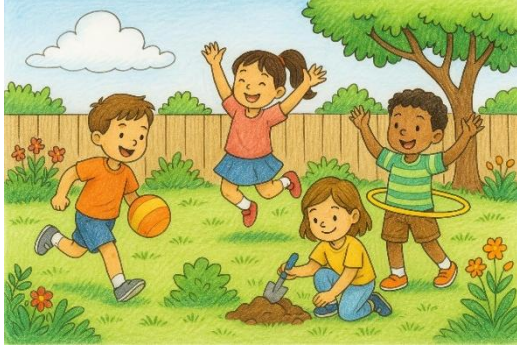
Q.1 Read the passage carefully and answer the following questions.
