The Satpura range is located between the river Narmada and river Tapi, which flow westwards into the Arabian Sea. The Deccan Plateau is the largest plateau of India. As we have read earlier, the plateau is bounded by the Western Ghats in the west and the Eastern Ghats in the east. The Western Ghats in the west of the Deccan plateau are a long range of hills. They include the Nilgiri hills, Anaimalai, and Cardamom hills. The Nilgiri hills lie in Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, and Kerala. Ooty is the hill station in the Nilgiri hills in the Deccan Plateau region. The Eastern Ghats have comparatively low hills as they have been cut up by a number of east-flowing rivers.
