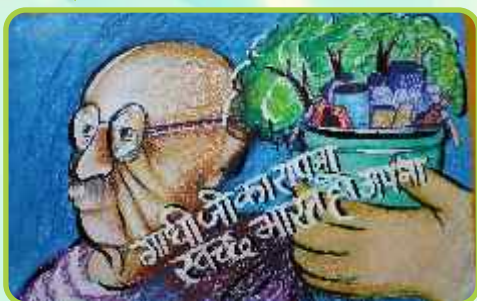
KPS OLYMPIAD—HONING THE BUSINESS SKILLS
