5. Find the average number of tourists visiting the districts.

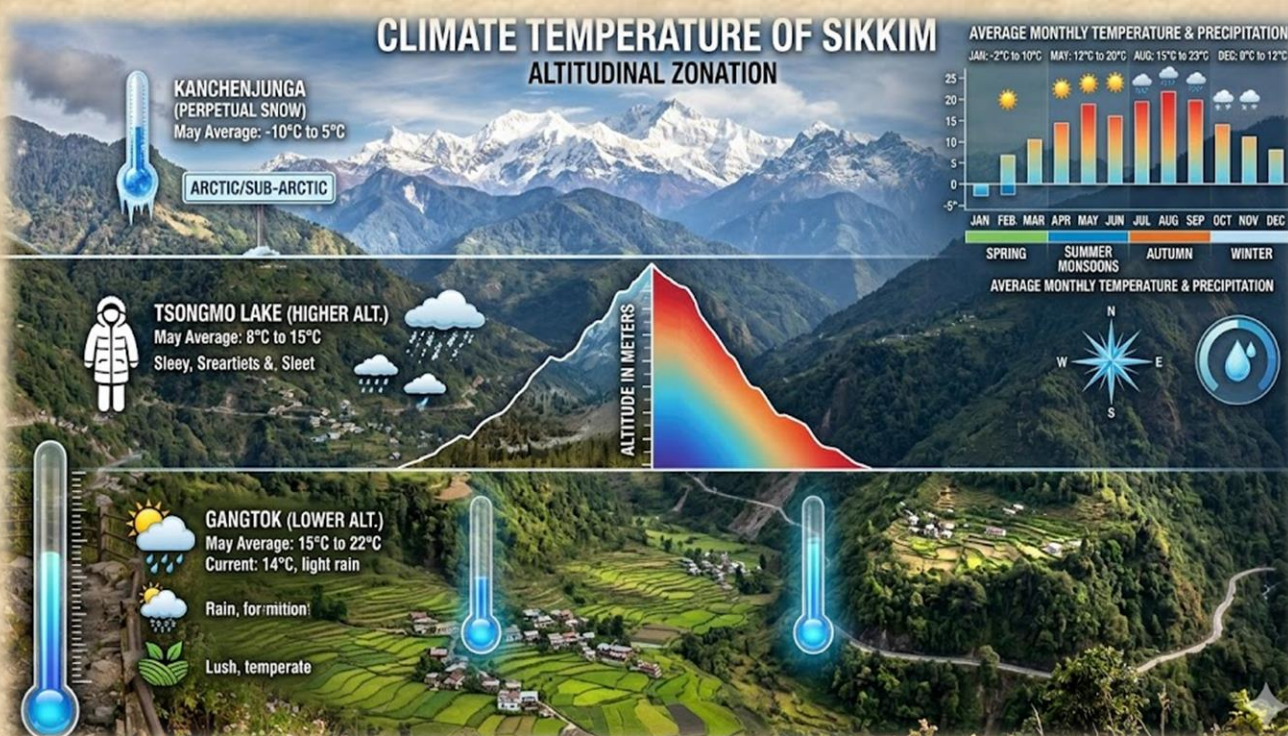
4. SCIENCE

Types of Puppets:

Steps:

1. Choose a character (animal, cartoon, social message).
2. Use materials like socks, paper, cloth, buttons, wool.
3. Design face and body.
4. Add movable parts if possible.

Make your puppet UNIQUE:

- * Create a theme-based character (animal, superhero, folk character)
- * Add movable parts (mouth, hands)
- * Use recycled materials creatively
- * Give your puppet a name and personality.

Project Option 2: Soap Making (Life Skill & Hygiene)

Design and create your own handmade soap using simple ingredients and present it in an innovative way.



Use simple and safe materials:

- * Soap base (glycerine)
- * Natural colours (turmeric, beetroot, coffee)
- * Fragrance (essential oils / rose water)
- * Add-ons (flower petals, herbs, oats)

👉 Steps (simple method):

1. Cut soap base into small pieces
2. Melt it using double boiler method
3. Add colour, fragrance, and ingredients
4. Pour into moulds
5. Let it cool and set

Make your soap UNIQUE:

- * Create layered or transparent soaps
- * Design fun shapes (fruits 🍓 , animals 🐼 , hearts ❤️)
- * Add eco-friendly elements (herbs, dried flowers 🌸)
- * Make a theme-based soap (summer freshness, herbal care, etc.)

Branding & Packaging

Turn your soap into a mini product:

- * Give it a brand name 🐦
- * Design a label (ingredients + benefits)
- * Create eco-friendly packaging (paper wrap, jute, leaves)
